1.Scope of the release

The objective of this document is to list the changes, modifications, decommissions, bug corrections that are part of the major release **18.7.0**

Timing

- Release on the INT environment : Thursday, 28 October 2021 from 9am to 1pm (**done**)
- **2nd Release on the INT environment : Thursday 09 December 2021 from 9am to 1pm**
- **Release on the PROD environment : Tuesday, 11 January 2022 8pm to midnight**

The main changes of this release are:

- **FAS UI Stateless**
 - The new FAS2-UI implementation has no visual functional differences and behaves the same as the previous implementation. It does provide more stability throughout the authentication process and is less error prone.
 - **Important remark: if you have monitoring active on the FAS, this new implementation is likely to have an impact on this functionality. Please consult the pdf 'BOSA_FASUI Stateless Change' for further technical details.**
- **Added itsme[®] to logon to DMA and HMA**
 - At the request of many users, itsme[®] has been added to authenticate on these applications.
- **'Unmask' feature for all password fields (XMA & FASUI)**
 - Users will have the possibility to hide and unhide their passwords in XMA and FASUI.
- **eIDAS: logging in 'with a valid European login method'**

As the number of EU countries that have implemented eIDAS (currently 12 countries) continuously increases, the overview of the active countries is sorted alphabetically, according to the official country codes. (e.g. **AT** – Austria, **CZ** – Czech Republic, **DE** – Germany, ...)
- **Typo fixes on the FASUI and SMA**
- **Backend bug fixes and corrections**
- **Optimisation of internal applications**
